### Being Authors and Readers



**Reading for Pleasure** – Viking Boy

**Narrative:** The Last Bear

**Poetry:** Free Verse Poetry

**Grammar** –Spring 1 plus using adverbs and adverbials to detail when, why, how and where a verb happened. Year 4 also recap and consolidate all previous learning as well as using standard English inflections accurately.

**Punctuation** – Spring 1 plus using a comma after simple fronted adverbials. Year 4 also recognize and use the terms determiner, pronoun, possessive pronouns and adverbial.

**Composition** – Draft, redraft and edit writing with increasing accuracy and to make improvements. Year 4 also continue to work on using bullet points, headings and subheadings when appropriate.
